Executive sessions of the Board may be held in the following instances (IC 5-14-1.5-6.1)

- ____(1) Where authorized by Federal or State statute.
- ____(2) For discussion of strategy with respect to:
 - ____(A) Collective bargaining;
 - ____(B) Initiation of litigation or litigation which is either pending or has been threatened specifically in writing;
 - ____(C) The implementation of a security system; or
 - ____(D) The purchase or lease of real property by the governing body up to the time a contract or option to purchase or lease is executed by the parties.
- ____(3) Interviews with industrial or commercial prospects or their agents by the Department of Commerce, the Employment Development Commission, the Film Commission, the Corporation of Science and Technology, the Export Finance Authority, or Economic Development Commission.
- ____(4) To receive information about, and/or to interview prospective employees. ____ (5) With respect to any individual over whom the governing body has jurisdiction:
 - XX ____ (A) To receive information concerning the individual's alleged misconduct; and
 - ____ (B) To discuss, prior to any determination, that individual's name status as an employee, student, or independent contractor who is a physician.
- ____(6) For discussion of records classified as confidential by Federal or State statute.
- ____(7) To discuss a job performance of individual employees. The subdivision does not apply to any discussion of the salary, compensation, or benefits of employees during a budget process.
- ____(8) When considering the appointment of a public official to:
 - ____(A) Develop a list of potential appointees;
 - ____(B) Consider applications;
 - ____(C) Make one (1) initial exclusion of perspective appointees from further consideration.
- ____(10) To discuss information and intelligence intended to prevent, mitigate, or respond to the threat of terrorism.
